A proper test-object must be chosen : the Moon is too easy ; Venus too severe, except for first-rate glasses ; large stars have too much glare; Jupiter or Saturn are far better; a close double star is best of all for an experienced eye ; but for general purposes a moderate-sized star will suffice.

A Darker View - Rev. T.W. Webb

Finders. Look for one that has an aperture (front lens) larger than an inch (25mm) and appears well-made. Dinky, nearly worthless finders are all too common on cheap telescopes. A popular alternative is the reflex sight, which projects a point or ring (s) of light on the background sky when you look from behind.
