**Diversity Visa Interview**

Prepare for the Interview. After you have been notified of your scheduled interview, you will need to take the following important steps in advance of the interview date: 1. Carefully Review your scheduling information in the Entrant Status Check on the E-DV website, noting the date, time, and location of your immigrant visa interview.

**Prepare for the Interview - Travel**

Interview. The total number of diversity visas is allocated by visa category and region of the world. The allocations are revised monthly as available visas are issued. Each month the Department of State publishes the Visa Bulletin which contains important information about updated allocations and the likelihood of a diversity visa number being...

**Diversity Visa Program - Interview - State**

Each diversity visa applicant is required to show that they are unlikely to become a "public charge" when in the United States, or primarily dependent on the U.S. Government for subsistence. To do this, you should be prepared to convincingly present evidence of independent resources to the consular officer on the day of your interview.

**The DV Interview | U.S. Embassy in Albania**

Under U.S. law, all diversity visas for a fiscal year must be issued prior to September 30 (the end of the fiscal year). Available visas for some countries and regions may be used up prior to that date. So, if you delay your appointment, you may lose your opportunity to immigrate on the basis of your DV application.
