The informal reading inventory is an on-going assessment, and should be completed several times throughout the child's schooling. In kindergarten, perform the informal reading inventory twice per year, at mid-year and at the end of school.

Types of Informal Classroom-Based Assessment

The great thing about informal assessments is they help us gauge students' understanding during the learning process instead of after. Informal assessment also changes teachers' relationship to student learning. Through informal assessment, a teacher becomes a guide throughout the learning process, rather than the judge of the student's final product.

Informal assessments are not data driven but rather content and performance driven. For example, running records are informal assessments because they indicate how well a student is reading a specific book. Scores such as 10 correct out of 15, percent of words read correctly, and most rubric scores are given from this type of assessment.
