A descriptive work of prose or poetry, a film, or even a photograph may thus highlight through its rhetorical vividness what is happening, or what is shown in, say, any of the visual arts, and in doing so, may enhance the original art and so take on a life of its own through its brilliant description.

### **Magical Realism in Global Literary and Cinematic Trauma ...**

Definition of Realism. In literature, writers use realism as a literary technique to describe story elements, such as setting, characters, themes, etc., without using elaborate imagery, or figurative language, such as similes and metaphors. Through realism, writers explain things without decorative language or sugar-coating the events.

### **Realism - Definition and Examples of Literary Terms**

Literary realism. Literary realism is part of the realist art movement beginning with mid nineteenth-century French literature ( Stendhal ), and Russian literature ( Alexander Pushkin) and extending to the late nineteenth and early twentieth century. Literary realism attempts to represent familiar things as they are.
